Our United States Naval Sea Cadet unit, the Rear Admiral Charles W. Parks Battalion located at RFTA Camp Parks, in Dublin, CA, is looking for corporate sponsorship of our unit. Our unit is growing and we need financial assistance to support our Cadet Corps and the various leadership, training, ceremonial and civic programs that we participate in each year.

Since 1958 the Naval Sea Cadet Corps (NSCC) has been committed to providing American youth, ages 10-17, who have a desire to learn about the Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard and Merchant Marine. Sea Cadets are authorized by the Secretary of the Navy to wear Navy uniforms appropriately marked with the Sea Cadet Corps insignia. The objectives of the Sea Cadet program are to introduce youth to naval life, to develop in them a sense of pride, patriotism, courage, and self-reliance, and to maintain an environment free of drugs and gangs and guide them to becoming mature young adults.

Recognizing the importance and benefits of the NSCC, Congress on September 10, 1962 federally incorporated the Naval Sea Cadet Corps under Public Law 87-655 (36 USC 1541).

I was a Sea Cadet myself during the early 1980s and I have carried many of what I learned and experienced during those years into my professional and family life.

Our unit drills one weekend each month and also participates in several community service outreach events throughout the year working close with the Pleasanton VFW and other veterans and community groups. The money we receive as a donation goes directly to our unit and helps facilitate sending cadets to trainings, provide travel costs as needed and help to supply uniforms and other essential gear for our cadets.

Our Programs

Our junior program, the Navy League Cadet Corps, is for youths ages 10 through 13. Our senior program, the Naval Sea Cadet Corps, is for youths age 13 through completion of high school. At each level, cadets are mentored by committed adults and peer leaders.

Membership Requirements

Prospective cadets must be drug-, alcohol- and gang-free while attending school full-time with at least a "C" average. The annual enrollment fee is determined by the unit.

Our Training Opportunities

Throughout the year, cadets regularly meet for activities with their local unit. During school vacations, cadets have the opportunity to participate in training events around the country and internationally. We offer programs in areas such as aviation, field and medical training, leadership development, military police science, scuba diving, seamanship, photojournalism and sailing. Cadets train aboard U.S. Navy and Coast Guard ships and can meet Sea Cadets from around the world on our International Exchange Program.
